Prior to the issuance of Site Improvement Permits, the Developer must provide to the City of Manassas Site Inspections the **name of an individual holding a certificate of competence**, who will be responsible for carrying out a "Regulated land disturbing activity."

Erosion and Sediment Control Requirements for Permit Approval:

If the name is not provided prior to regulated land-disturbing activity the plans approval may be revoked and the person responsible for carrying out the plan would be subject to penalties under Erosion and Sediment Control Law.

Effective in July 2001, as a prerequisite for erosion and sediment control plan approval throughout Virginia, the person responsible for carrying out the plan must provide the name of an individual holding a (RLD) Certificate who will be in charge of and responsible for carrying out a regulated "land-disturbing activity."

Responsible Land Disturber (RLD) means an individual holding a certificate of competence issued by DCR who will be in charge of and responsible for carrying out the land-disturbing activity in accordance with the approved plan.

The RLD may be the owner, applicant, permittee, designer, superintendent, project manager, contractor, or any other project or development team member. The RLD must be designated as a prerequisite for obtaining City permit and prior to any land disturbing activities. Ref VESCH
