Now and Then Trunk *(recommended for K & 1st graders)*

- **Let's Go Shopping**

Students will take a trip to the downtowns of the past. What was it like to go shopping in 1900? What could you buy? Who could shop together, sit together on the train, or have lunch together? What was different in 1920, or in 1950? What about today? A Museum staff member will help students discover what things have changed over time and what things have stayed the same.

- **Communication and Transportation**

From walking to space shuttles, writing to satellites, students will compare the ways that people and information move from place to place in past and present.

- **Trunk Q&A Session**

A Museum staff member will give a detailed review of the materials provided in the trunk and answer students' questions about what the items are and how they were used.
